

COMMUNITY GROUP GUIDE 1 CORINTHIANS 2:1-16

INTRODUCTION

This study guide is to help individuals and groups learn and apply the truths of Scripture to where you are in life right now. To get the most from this study guide, work through it on your own before gathering with your community group.

As we move into 1 Corinthians 2, Paul continues to encourage the church back toward their true purpose. He explains that their message should simply be Christ and Him crucified. This message challenged the church at Corinth, a center of lofty speech and show where it was culturally important to be in a position of recognition and prominence. Paul, knowing the nature of the city, directly attacks the worldly way of crafty language and formal presentation. He explains that the church should proclaim Christ above everything else and that, through the ministry of the Holy Spirit, we have everything necessary to do it.

Paul reminds the church that they cannot ascend to God and receive the gift of the Spirit on their own, though. He reveals himself to His people, then gives them the humility to become bold proclaimers of his message. Paul simply calls the Church at Corinth to rely solely on the power of the Holy Spirit. The church cannot accomplish it's purpose apart from the ministry of the Holy Spirit. Paul's encouragement gives a clear picture that the church should be humble before the Lord. The Lord promises to empower His people for the purpose of gospel proclamation.
