



Procedures, Policies, & Expectations of Caregivers

In order to complete your registration, please read the following information and indicate on the kids' registration form that you have read and agree to abide by the safety policies and procedures as outlined below. Please note: There are a limited number of spaces available in each of these classrooms/spaces.

MercyKids offers gospel-centered programming at all services at each of our campuses:

Northeast campus: ages 6 months through 5th grade at 9am
Providence Road campus: ages 6 months through 5th grade at 9 am & 11 am

We are committed to:

- Faithfully teaching the Word of God to your children in an age-appropriate way
- Challenging our learners to live out the gospel in their everyday lives in an age-appropriate way
- Cleaning all MercyKids environments before and in between service times
- Maintaining safe volunteer-to-child ratios per age group. We commit to always having ≥ 2 background-checked adults in each classroom space.

Drop off and Pick Up Procedures:

- Drop off: Please do not enter the classroom, a team member will meet you and your child at the door
- Pick up: Please have your security tag ready to show at the time of pickup
 - If you lose/do not have a pickup tag, a photo ID will be required for pickup and must match a name provided at check-in as a parent/guardian/person authorized to pick up your child
 - The MercyKids Campus Associate or Check-In team member can assist you at the check-in cart

Safety Protocols for MercyKids:

MercyKids will do everything possible to keep our spaces safe and healthy for your child. We ask you to adhere to the following additional protocols in partnership with us:

- No personal comfort items (with the exception of a labeled or clipped-on pacifier for Cuddlers or Cruisers) should be brought into the classroom
- No snacks will be consumed during class - you are welcome to provide a drink in a clearly labeled bottle or sippy cup with a tight-fitting lid (mostly applicable to our Cuddlers age group)

Additional Health + Safety Expectations of Caregivers:

Parents, guardians, or caretakers are expected to ensure that children are in good health and have not exhibited any of the below symptoms in the 24 hours prior to MercyKids. Children should be symptom-free without the aid of medicine for 24-48 hours before joining a classroom space.

Symptoms: fever, chills, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, new cough/congestion/runny nose, loss of taste/smell, diarrhea, vomiting
